6 Klein High School Musicians Make All-State

Six Klein High School music students have been named to Texas Music Educators Association All-State ensembles.

Selected for All-State Choir are Savannah Boyd, Emmalie Hall, and Rebecca Walsh.

Selected for All-State Orchestra are Andres Ayerbe, Kyle Victor, and Ruoxuan (Rosa) Su.

These students will perform with the Texas All-State Choir and Texas All-State Orchestra on February 11th as part of the 2017 TMEA Clinic and Convention. The students were chosen for this honor through a competitive process held this year across the state at district, region and area levels. All State is the highest honor a Texas music student can receive.

The Texas Music Educators Association sponsors the All-State competition. This competitive process begins across the state. More than 1,600 students are selected through a process that begins with over 60,000 students from around the state vying for this honor to perform in one of 15 ensembles (bands, choirs, and orchestras).

Only the top 3% of musicians who initially audition become All State musicians.

These All-State musicians participate in three days of rehearsals directed by nationally recognized conductors during the TMEA Clinic/Convention.
