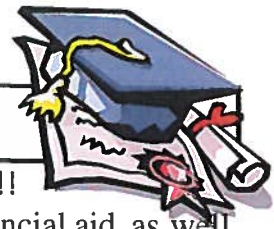

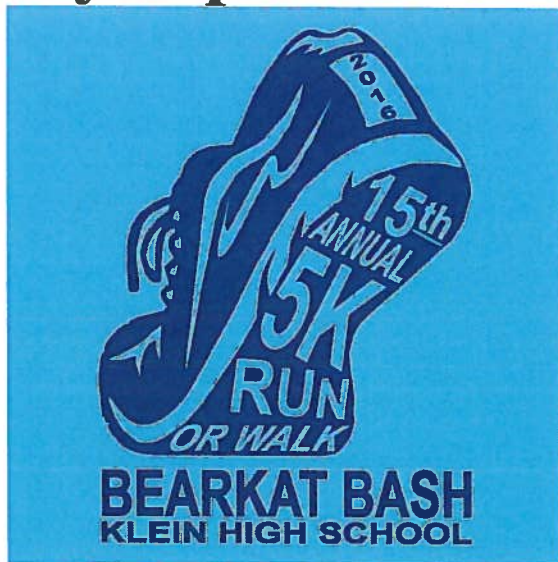
Welcome class of 2020

Metal Detector Letter to Parents

Dear Parents:

The Klein Independent School District has a deep concern for the safety and security of its students and employees. To address these concerns video cameras have been installed, random parking lot drug searches before and during the school day have been implemented, human-canine teams make regular visits to the campus, and each high school campus has full time police officers and a parking lot monitor on duty during the school day.

As described in the student handbook, an additional procedure has been implemented to further secure the high school and intermediate campuses. All high schools and intermediates have been provided with hand held metal detectors, which will be used solely on a random basis. Students in randomly selected classrooms and/or buses will be scanned using the hand held metal detectors. Should there be an alert, students will be asked to cooperate in determining the cause of the alert. If requested, this may be done in an area other than the classroom. Walk through metal detectors may be used on some campuses in a similar manner.

The purpose of implementing these new security measures is to prevent any student from bringing guns or any illegal weapons into the school building. Zero tolerance of guns and illegal weapons means that the KISD will not accept excuses. Therefore, those who possess these objects will be arrested. Your cooperation and support are greatly appreciated.

ZERO TOLERANCE EQUALS ZERO EXCUSES EQUALS 100% ARRESTS

The Klein Independent School District (KISD) has a deep concern for the safety and security of its students, employees, and patrons while they are attending football games at Klein Memorial Stadium. To address this societal issue the school district has installed video cameras in various locations of the stadium and the cameras are monitored throughout the event. In addition, there is a screening process that includes the use of metal detectors.

All Patrons, employees, and students will be scanned and the contents of purses, backpacks, and other similar items will be inspected upon entry to the stadium if the alarm is activated. Unneeded metal objects should be left at home. It is suggested that spectators arrive at the KISD stadium early enough to allow the time necessary for this procedure.

The purpose of implementing these security measures is to prevent anyone from bringing guns or any illegal weapons into the stadium. The KISD police officers will be assisted by trained staff members. Zero tolerance of guns and illegal weapons means that the KISD will not accept any excuses. Therefore, those who possess these objects will be arrested. Your cooperation and your support are greatly appreciated.

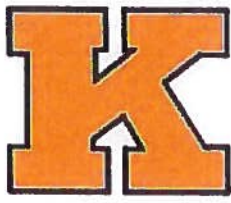

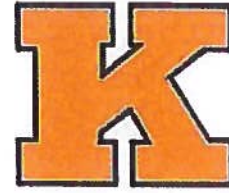
